SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay.

SENATOR BROMM: ...and as long as they're prohibited from accepting it, that might take care of that concern, if you have no big problem with that.

SENATOR BEUTLER: No, I think that's...I can see that there might be problems that would require further definition anyway, and we're certainly not prepared for extensive redefining at this point in time. So if that would make it acceptable, that certainly covers most of the ground that we'd be concerned with, I think, if we just had the word "accepted".

SENATOR BROMM: Thank you.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Senator Bromm. Mr. Clerk, an amendment to the amendment.

CLERK: Senator Schellpeper would move to amend the amendment, Mr. President. (Schellpeper amendment, FA580, appears on page 2011 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR HALL: Senator Schellpeper, to open on the amendment.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Mr. Chairman and members, this amendment to the amendment will just strike "solicit or", so it will read, "or the Legislature shall accept such contributions during the regular or special legislative session". So, it would mean that we cannot accept anything, but the "solicit or" would be withdrawn. I would move for the adoption of the amendment to the amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Senator Schellpeper. Is there any discussion on the Schellpeper amendment to the Beutler amendment? Seeing none, the question is, shall the...any close?
