SENATOR HALL: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Right, it's the other side of the coin, as Senator Schimek put it, just as a principal, lobbyist, or anyone acting on their behalf cannot contribute,...

SENATOR WESELY: Okay.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...a candidate cannot accept.

SENATOR WESELY: Oh, okay, all right. Thank you.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Senator Wesely. Any other discussion of the Beutler amendment? Seeing none, Senator Beutler to close. Senator Beutler waives closing. The question is the adoption of the Beutler amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Beutler's amendment.

SENATOR HALL: The Beutler amendment is adopted. Next item on the bill, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Beutler would move to amend with AM4356.

SENATOR HALL: Senator Beutler, to open on your amendment.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I would withdraw that one, Senator.

SENATOR HALL: It is withdrawn. Next item, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Lynch would move to amend the bill, Mr. President. (See AM4563 found on pages 2011-14 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR HALL: Senator Lynch. Is anyone authorized to carry Senator Lynch's amendment? Okay, Senator Lynch is on his way.
