

SENATOR LYNCH: ...what is the word I am looking for, of officials.

SENATOR BROMM: Thank you Senator Lynch. I think this is one of the areas with a particular amendment that I would want to see a little more refinement before we put it in the statutes. We certainly don't require our staff members to fall into this category and I don't think Senator Lynch wants to hold people who work for the colleges to a higher standard than we hold ourselves, certainly. So, I believe that needs a little work. Now, Speaker Withem had a series of informal gatherings of people while this legislation was being developed after it came out of committee...

SPEAKER WITHEM: Time.

SENATOR BROMM: Thank you.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Robinson.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Mr. Speaker and members of the body, Senator Lynch, does...your amendment just applies to the state college and the state university. Am I correct on that? Is that basically...does it cover any other individuals....

SENATOR LYNCH: Yes sir, it does. It involves and includes the...the University Board of Regents. It involves the commission, the Nebraska Highway Commission, it involves people that are involved with the Natural Resources District and it also involves....

SENATOR ROBINSON: May I stop and ask you...

SENATOR LYNCH: Yeah, they are included in the different sections of the law.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Now the NRD Board and the Board of Regents, don't they have to file disclosure and statements like we do when we are running for office? I think they do.

SENATOR LYNCH: Page 3, on line 17, where it says, the language is, "An individual holding an administrative or faculty position with a state college or state university", and then it goes on and describes what they would have to do.
