CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 2047 of the Legislative Journal.) 40 ayes, 4 nays, 2 present and not voting, 3 excused and not voting.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 1044 passes. LB 1292.

CLERK: (Read LB 1292 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 1292 pass? Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 2048 of the Legislative Journal.) 38 ayes, 2 nays, 6 present and not voting, 3 excused and not voting.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 1292 passes. LB, and as I previously indicated we will pass over 694, 694A and 1066 and go to LB 1310.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 1310 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: All provision of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 1310 pass with the emergency clause attached? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 2049 of the Legislative Journal.) 44 ayes, 1 nay, 1 present and not voting, 3 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 1310 passes with the emergency clause attached. LB 1015.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Bohlke, I had amendments from you, Senator, with a note that you wish to withdraw? Senator Kristensen, I had two amendments, Senator, notes to withdraw both? Thank you. (Read LB 1015 on Final Reading.)
