SENATOR PIRSCH: Thank you, Madam President and members of the body. This is kind of a unique moment in history. Childcare providers do play an increasingly important role in our children's lives as many children spend as much, or more time, during the work week under the childcare providers guidance and supervision than they do under the parents guidance
