SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you. Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, we have a number of appointments to consider from the Health and Human Services Committee. First, Michael Cullen is to take the seat on the Board of Health, representing podiatrists. We have three appointees to the Commission for the Hearing Impaired, Janet Haun, Richard McCowin, and Michael Gooch. We did hold a hearing regarding these individuals and unanimously recommend that they be approved by the Legislature. I move that their nominations be confirmed.
