SENATOR WESELY: Thank you. Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, these are two appointees to the Rural Health Advisory Commission. One is Janet Fletcher, from Senator Dierks' district out in O'Neill, and the second one is from Senator Matzke's district, I believe, Donna (sic) Fiesterman, who is from Lewellen. These two individuals are appointed to the Rural Health Advisory Commission. The committee did hear and consider their nominations and recommend that they be confirmed.
