PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 694A passes. LB 1066.

CLERK: (Read LB 1066 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER WITHEM PRESIDING

SPEAKER WITHEM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 1066E pass? All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 2068-69 of the Legislative Journal.) 34 ayes, 5 nays, 9 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting.

SPEAKER WITHEM: LB 1066 passes with the emergency clause attached. LB 1224E.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion to suspend the rules to permit the balance of Final Reading this afternoon. That is offered by Senators Wesely, oop, wrong motion, Mr. President, never mind.

SPEAKER WITHEM: That was a good motion though, it was. Whatever that was, it's withdrawn.

CLERK: It has gone away, yes, sir. (Read LB 1224 on Final Reading.)

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 2070 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 38 ayes, 9 nays, 1 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting.

Would like to announce to members that we have kind of passed three fairly long bills here and we have, as we do, become somewhat lax about the Final Reading stay in your seats requirement.
