SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Madam President, I had requested a roll call vote. I would like to withdraw that and go with a board vote and see where it goes, and if I need to, I will do a roll call.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. Are you ready to proceed or do you wish to wait until those last four senators arrive? There are four senators who are still not here.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Let's go ahead, and then if I need to, I will do a roll call.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The question before you is the adoption of the motion to suspend the rules for LR 15. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 7 nays on the motion to suspend the rules, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The rules are suspended. Senator Kristensen. Excuse me, we are on Final Reading.

CLERK: (Read LR 15CA on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LR 15 pass? All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 2132 of the Legislative Journal.) 30 ayes, 13 nays, 3 present and not voting, 3 excused and not voting.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LR 15 passes. We now move to motions to override the gubernatorial vetoes.

CLERK: Madam President, the first motion I have with respect to the Governor's action on LB 991 is by Senator Lindsay. Senator Lindsay would move to override the Governor's line-item veto of funds appropriated to the Supreme Court, for Program 52 for FY 1994-95 and FY 1995-96.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Lindsay. Senator Lindsay.
