SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Senator Hall. Senator Hall, your light was on to speak. Senator Moore, followed by Senator Robinson.

SENATOR MOORE: I guess, very briefly, as Senator Hall mentions in his memo, even with this veto there is a \$165,000 in the budget for this program. If that amount is not enough, it is prorated out to all the people that participate and Senator Hall is correct in saying that the participation has increased significantly in recent years, so that an argument can be made if you want to fully fund the thing, yes, you ought to fund it at this level. But I would submit there are many things that we have not fully funded. Obviously, DED and mental health come to mind, along with some other things, and if it is your desire to always fully fund this, it is going to continue to go up, and up, and up. You know, make the decision, whatever you will, it is \$50,000, \$150,000 for the biennium. I would urge the body to stand pat and sustain the Governor's veto on this motion as well.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Robinson.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Call the question.
