CLERK: 40 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The house is under call. Members who are currently not present, please return to the Chamber. Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: I would accept call-in votes on the override, but I think we're going to have to use a roll call though.

SPEAKER WITHEM: He would accept call-in votes, but beings he is not getting any, he's going to...we'll go for a roll call vote when the other three members have arrived. Senators Matzke and Landis, Senator Landis and Matzke. Senator Lindsay has requested a reverse order on calling the names of the two absent members, so Senator Matzke and Landis. All members are present. Call the roll.

CLERK: (Began to take roll call vote.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: Did you request the reverse order on...that was my mistake, that was my mistake, Mr. Clerk, call the roll in regular order, please. Senator Hall did request the roll call and when we asked for a clarification, he requested it be in regular order so it will be in regular order.
