PRESIDENT ROBAK PRESIDING

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our prayer this morning will be by the chaplain, Harland Johnson.

HARLAND JOHNSON: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you. We now begin the sixth day of the legislative session. Would the senators please record your presence.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Are there any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chair recognizes Senator Matzke.

SENATOR MATZKE: Madam President, I move that the rules as now in our possession be adopted for today only, Wednesday, January 11, 1995.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The motion is adoption of temporary rules. All those in favor say aye. All those opposed nay. Motion carries, we have temporary rules. Are there any messages, reports and announcements, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Madam President, I have received a Reference Report referring LB 114-177, as well as three constitutional amendments. I have a series of appointments to a variety of special committees as authorized and approved by the Executive Board: appointments to the Building and Maintenance Committee, Education Commission of the State, Midwestern Higher Education Compact, and the Legislative Program Evaluation Committee; a hearing notice from Judiciary Committee. LR 5 is ready for your signature, has reported correctly enrolled. (See pages 234-35 of the Legislative Journal.) Vice Chair of the General Affairs Committee has been selected, Senator Will has been designated as Vice Chair. A series of reports, one from the State Claims Board, report from the Board of Educational Lands and Funds, and the Nebraska Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice. That's all that I have at this time, Madam President.
