PRESIDENT ROBAK PRESIDING

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. We will begin the prayer this morning by Chaplain Harland Johnson.

HARLAND JOHNSON: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you. I now call the Legislature to order for its seventh day. Will senators please check in.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Are there any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections this morning, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chair recognizes Senator Matzke.

SENATOR MATZKE: Madam President, I move that the rules, as now in our possession, be adopted for today only, Thursday, January 12, 1995.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Is there any discussion? Seeing none, all those in favor say aye. All those opposed nay. The motion is adopted. We have temporary rules. Mr. Clerk, are there any messages, reports and announcements?

CLERK: Madam President, yes, I do, thank you. Reference Report from the Reference Committee referring LB 178-249, as well as both constitutional amendments. I have a motion from Senator Schmitt to withdraw LR 12. That will be laid over pursuant to our rules. Madam President...I guess that's all.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do hereby sign LR 5. We now turn to the introduction of new bills.

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Chambers has offered a proposal this morning. LB 372. (Read for the first time by title. See page 260 of the Legislative Journal.) That's all I have at this time.
