PRESIDENT ROBAK PRESIDING

PRESIDENT ROBAK: (Microphone not activated.) ...George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. The chaplain for today is Pastor Carol Roettmer-Brewer, from South Gate Methodist Church, here in Lincoln. Pastor.

PASTOR ROETTNER-BREWER: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Pastor. I now call the 13th legislative day to order. Will senators please record your presence.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Are there any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections this morning, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Any messages, reports and announcements?

CLERK: Just one item. Reference Report received from Reference Committee referring LBs 651 through 729. That's all that I have this morning, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We turn to agenda Item number 5, General File bills, LR 4CA.

CLERK: Madam President, LR 4CA was a constitutional amendment introduced by Senator Kristensen. (Read summary.) The resolution was introduced on January 5 of this year, at that time referred to the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee for public hearing. The resolution was advanced to General File. I have no amendments pending at this time, Madam President.
