SENATOR CROSBY PRESIDING

SENATOR CROSBY: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen, and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. This is January 24th (sic), the thirteenth (sic) day of the Ninety-Fourth Legislature, First Session.
