SENATOR CROSBY PRESIDING

SENATOR CROSBY: (Microphone not activated) ...ladies and gentlemen, and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. This is the twenty-second day of the Ninety-Fourth Legislature, First Session, Tuesday, February 7.
