SENATOR CROSBY PRESIDING

SENATOR CROSBY: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. This is the twenty-fourth day, Thursday, February 9th, 1995 of the Ninety-Fourth Legislature, First Session. Our chaplain for the day is Pastor Ed Brown from the Second Baptist Church in Lincoln. CLERK: I have a quorum present, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. Any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections this morning, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: Any messages, reports or announcements?

CLERK: Just one item, the Committee on Judiciary gives notice of hearing for February 16. That's the only item I have this morning, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. Will the senators please take their seats so we might begin Final Reading. Would the senators please take their seats so we might begin Final Reading. The first bill on Final Reading this morning is LB 1. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read LB 1 on Final Reading.)
