PRESIDENT ROBAK: (Microphone not activated immediately.)
...ladies and gentlemen and welcome to the George W. Norris
Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain for the day is from Senator
Lynch's district in Omaha; it's Pastor Jim Hardy of the Florence
Christian Church. Pastor Hardy.
