SPEAKER WITHEM PRESIDING

SPEAKER WITHEM: (Mike not activated immediately.)
...fifty-first legislative day here in the George W. Norris legislative Chamber. We're very pleased this morning to have our chaplain for the day come up and visit us from Tecumseh down in Senator Vrtiska's district. From the Faith Baptist Church we have Pastor Dan Gonnerman.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 548 has been discussed. It was a bill originally introduced by Senator Beutler. It's a bill relating to campaign finance. Senator Wesely had offered a motion to indefinitely postpone. Senator Beutler agreed to lay the bill over. That motion is pending.
