PRESIDENT ROBAK PRESIDING

PRESIDENT ROBAK: (Microphone not activated immediately.)
...Legislative Chamber for our third day of the Legislature.
Our prayer this morning is by Chaplain Harland Johnson.

HARLAND JOHNSON: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: I now call the third day of the Legislature to order. Will senators please record their presence. Please record.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. The Chair recognizes Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Thank you, Madam President. I move that the rules as now in our possession be adopted for today only, January 5, 1996.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Will. The question before you is the adoption of the temporary rules. All those in favor say aye. All those opposed nay. Temporary rules are adopted. Mr. Clerk, are there any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Any messages, reports and announcements?

CLERK: Madam President, the only items I have are Reference Report referring LBs 890 through 1006 and constitutional amendments that have been introduced. Those will be referred to the appropriate committee. Pursuant to that action, Madam President, I have a communication from Senator Bohlke, as Chair of Education. She has selected LB 900 as one of the two Education priority bills for this session. I believe that's all that I have, Madam President.
