PRESIDENT ROBAK PRESIDING

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Our chaplain for the day is Pastor Ken Hoover from Peace Lutheran Church in Waverly. Pastor Hoover.

PASTOR HOOVER: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Pastor Hoover. I now call the fourteenth legislative day to order. Will senators please record their presence.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Messages, reports, and announcements.

CLERK: Priority bill designation by Senator Fisher, who has selected LB 930 for this session. Attorney General's Opinion addressed to Senator Schellpeper (re: LB 915). And Senator Hillman would like to print amendments to LB 584. (See pages 568-76 of the Legislative Journal.) That's all that I have this morning, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Return now to Select File and LB 106.

CLERK: Madam President, on LB 106 on Select File. On March 19 of last year, the Enrollment and Review amendments were considered and adopted. The bill was...I'm sorry, that was on May 19, excuse me. And then on May 19 Senator Dierks moved to bracket the bill until this year. I do have one amendment pending from Senator Withem.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Is anyone prepared to handle the Withem amendment? Seeing no one, we'll pass over that amendment. Senator Dierks, there are no further amendments at this time, if you would refresh our memory as to where we are on this bill.

SENATOR DIERKS: Thank you, Madam President and members of the Legislature. Last year, if you recall, we had a fairly lengthy discussion on this bill before advancing it to Select File. To
