SENATOR CROSBY PRESIDING

SENATOR CROSBY: Good morning and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain for the day is Pastor Darrell Sheeley from the Highland Missionary Baptist Church. And he's the guest of Senator Eric Will. Pastor.

PASTOR SHEELEY: (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR CROSBY: I now call to order the nineteenth day, Thursday, February 1, 1996, of the Ninety-Fourth Legislature, Second Session. Roll call.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. Any corrections to the Journal, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: I have no corrections this morning, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: Messages, reports, announcements.

CLERK: Your committee on Education, Chaired by Senator Bohlke, reports 1138 to General File with amendments, 1024 indefinitely postponed, and 1142 indefinitely postponed. General Affairs Committee reports 932 to General File, that signed by Senator Schellpeper as Chair. A hearing notice from the Urban Affairs Committee by Senator Hartnett. Senator Lynch would like to print amendments to 106. And a gubernatorial appointment letter, appointment to the Central Interstate Low-Level Radioactive Waste Commission. That will be referred to Reference for referral to standing committee for a confirmation hearing, Madam President. (See pages 669-74 of the Legislative Journal.) And that's all that I have this morning.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. We'll move to General File. Mr. Clerk, LB 964.

CLERK: Madam President, LB 964 was a bill originally introduced by Senator Cudaback, Dierks, Janssen, Schmitt, and Vrtiska. (Read title.) It was introduced on January 3 of this year. At that time it was referred to the Government Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. I have no amendments at this time, Madam President.
