SENATOR CROSBY PRESIDING

SENATOR CROSBY: (Recorder not activated immediately) ...of the Castelar Presbyterian Church, and he is the guest of Senator Hilgert this morning. Pastor.

PASTOR PETER MacFARLANE: (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Pastor. I now open the twenty-second day, Tuesday, February 6, 1996, of the Ninety-Fourth Legislature, Second Session. Roll call.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: Any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections this morning.

SENATOR CROSBY: Any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: Enrollment and Review reports LB 645 and LB 1141A to Select File, one of which has Enrollment and Review amendments. Senator Chambers selected LB 901 as his priority bill for this session. That's all that I have, Madam President. (See pages 713-18 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We will go on to General File and I will remind the senators to keep their conversations down so we may hear the speakers. (Gavel.) LR 43CA, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Madam President, Legislative Resolution 43 originally introduced by Senator Schellpeper and a number of members (Read brief explanation.) The resolution was referred to General Affairs, advanced to General File. It was considered on January 31 of this year. At that time, Senator Schellpeper had offered amendments to the resolution, amendments to the committee amendments, I should say. Prior to acting on those, Senator Chambers had moved to bracket the resolution until June 1, 1996. That is the motion before the body at this time, Madam President, motion to bracket.
