PRESIDENT ROBAK PRESIDING

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Good morning and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain for the day is Captain Bob Miles of the Salvation Army, here in Lincoln. Captain Miles.

CAPTAIN MILES: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Captain Miles. I now call the twenty-fifth legislative day to order. Will senators please record your presence. Please record.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Any messages, reports and announcements?

CLERK: Senator Hartnett has selected LB 1373 as his priority bill for this session. Attorney General Opinion addressed to Senator Warner. And a report, two reports from the Nebraska Investment Finance Authority. That's all that I have this morning, Madam President. (See pages 753-56 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We turn now to General File and begin with LB 754.

CLERK: LB 754, Madam President, a bill originally introduced by Senator Bohlke. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 19, referred to the Education Committee, advanced to General File with committee amendments. Committee amendments were adopted on February 5 of this year, Madam President. At that time there was pending...Senator Bernard-Stevens...Senator Bernard-Stevens had an amendment. Senator, I had FA426. I also have a note, you had an amendment to the bill and an amendment to the amendment. And I understand you're considering withdrawing the amendment to the amendment, so we can then...
