SENATOR CROSBY PRESIDING

SENATOR CROSBY: (Recorder not activated immediately.) ...to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain for the day is Pastor J.L. Jones with Emmanuel Baptist Church in Grand Island. And he is the guest of Senator Fisher this morning. Pastor.

PASTOR JONES: (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Pastor. I now call to order the thirty-second day, Friday, February 23, 1996 of the Ninety-Fourth Legislature, Second Session. Roll call. Please record your presence.
