SENATOR COORDSEN PRESIDING

SENATOR COORDSEN: Good morning, welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber for the thirty-ninth day of the Second Session of the Ninety-Fourth Legislature. Our chaplain for the day is Father Nicholas Baker from Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Crete, that is in Senator Coordsen, or my district, and I'm very happy to have Father Baker with us this morning. FATHER BAKER: (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR COORDSEN: I now call to order the thirty-ninth day, Second Session, Ninety-Fourth Legislature. Roll call.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Corrections to the Journal.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have no corrections this morning.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Messages, reports, and announcements.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have neither messages, reports, or announcements this morning.
