PRESIDENT ROBAK PRESIDING

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Good morning and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain for this morning is Chaplain Harland Johnson.

HARLAND JOHNSON: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you. I now call the forty-eighth legislative day to order. Will senators please record your presence. Please record.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Are there any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections this morning, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Any messages, reports and announcements?

CLERK: A lobby report for this past week to be inserted in the Journal and I have a resolution ready for your signature, Madam President. That's all that I have. (See pages 1438-39 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do hereby sign Legislative Resolution 335. We now turn to Final Reading. Will senators all be seated, please. We are in Final Reading. Senators, please be seated. LB 906.

CLERK: (Read LB 906 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 906 pass? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 1439 of the Legislative Journal.) 35 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 12 excused and not voting, Madam President.
