SENATOR CROSBY PRESIDING

SENATOR CROSBY: Good morning and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain for the day is Pastor Paul Petersen, retired and still working though as an interim pastor in the Lutheran Church. He lives here in Lincoln. Pastor.
