SPEAKER WITHEM: Ladies and gentlemen, welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber as we begin the fifty-third legislative day, the Ninety-Fourth Legislature, Second Session. Like to introduce the director of Day Watch from here in Lincoln, the chaplain for the day, Pastor Nancy Erickson.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Are there any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Messages, reports, and announcements'

CLERK: Enrollment and Review reports LB 465, 465A, 1277, 1070, 1241 to Select File. And Natural Resources Committee reports 731 to General File with committee amendments attached, and that's signed by Senator Beutler. (See pages 1672-76 of the Legislative Journal.) That's all that I have, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you. Would the body please prepare itself for Final Reading. Members, you're to be on your seats, we are on Final Reading. Please take your seats. Mr. Clerk, LB 1252.

CLERK: (Read LB 1252 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 1252 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have all of you wishing to vote voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 1676 of the Legislative Journal.) 34 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 13 excused and not voting.
