PRESIDENT ROBAK PRESIDING

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Good morning and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain for the day is Pastor George Cook of Fellowship Community Church here in Lincoln. Pastor Cook.

PASTOR COOK: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Pastor. I now call the fifty-eighth legislative day to order. Will senators please record your presence.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Madam President.
