PRESIDENT ROBAK PRESIDING

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Good morning and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Welcome to the third day. We will open with a prayer by the Chaplain, Harland Johnson.

HARLAND JOHNSON: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you for the prayer. I now call the third day of the Legislature to order. Will senators please record their presence.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. The Chair recognizes Speaker Withem.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Madam President, members, I would move that the rules, as now in our possession, be adopted for today only, Friday, January 10, 1997.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: You heard the motion. All those in favor of adopting temporary rules say aye. All those opposed nay. Temporary rules are adopted. Mr. Clerk, any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections to the Journal, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Any messages, reports and announcements?

CLERK: Madam President, I have a series of proposed rules changes being submitted by Senator Will, as Chair of the Rules Committee. Those will be inserted in the Journal. (See pages 153-56 of the Legislative Journal.) I have some gubernatorial appointment letters appointing Mr. Donald Leuenberger, as Policy Secretary, and that will be referred to the Reference Committee for referral to a Standing Committee for a confirmation hearing. Two (sic) Attorney General's Opinions to be inserted. (See pages 156-62 of the Legislative Journal.) And Senator Will has been selected as Vice Chair of the General Affairs Committee.
