SPEAKER WITHEM: (Microphone not on)...Legislative Chamber as we begin today, the sixth day of the Ninety-Fifth Legislature, First Session. Very pleased to have from Lincoln here the First Presbyterian Church, the Associate Pastor, Nancy Redman. Pastor.
