SPEAKER WITHEM PRESIDING

SPEAKER WITHEM: Well, good morning, ladies and gentlemen. Welcome to George W. Norris Legislative Chamber as we begin today, the eighth day of the Ninety-Fifth Legislature, First Session. Very pleased to have with us the executive director of the People's City Mission here in Lincoln, our chaplain for the day, is Pastor Ron Buchinski.

PASTOR BUCHINSKI: (Prayer offered.)

CLERK: Thank you, Pastor.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you very much. Members, please report to the Chamber, record your presence.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Mr. Clerk are there any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections this morning, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: How about messages, reports and announcements?

CLERK: Just one item: the lobby registration report for the period up to and including January 16, 1997. That's all that I have this morning, Mr. President. (See pages 300-01 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. First item on the agenda today will be legislative resolutions. We have two of those. They will be addressed collectively. To remind you as to how that is done, we will introduce the introducer, in this case Senator Robak, who will introduce both resolutions, and then we'll vote on them collectively. (LR 33-34) Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Robak offers Legislative Resolution 33. It's found on page 168 of the Legislative Journal.

SPEAKER WITHEM: And also Legislative Resolution 34.
