PRESIDENT ROBAK PRESIDING

PRESIDENT ROBAK: (Microphone not functional)...Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain for the day is Pastor Mike Young of the Church of Christ here in Lincoln. Pastor Young.

PASTOR YOUNG: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Pastor Young. I now call the twelfth day of the Ninety-Fifth Legislature to session. Will senators please record your presence.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections this morning, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Messages, reports, and announcements?

CLERK: Just one item. I have the lobby report for the week ending January 23. That will be inserted in the Journal. (See pages 425-26 of the Legislative Journal.) It's the only item I have, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We turn now to General File and LB 9.

CLERK: Madam President, LB 9 was originally introduced by Senator Coordsen. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 9, referred to the Transportation Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending. (Committee amendment AM0016 can be found on page 417 of the Legislative Journal.)
