SENATOR COORDSEN PRESIDING

SENATOR COORDSEN: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen. Welcome to the George W. Norris Chamber for the eighteenth day of the Ninety-Fifth Legislative Session. Our chaplain for the day is Pastor David Argue, from Christ's Place Church, right here in Lincoln. Pastor Argue.

PASTOR ARGUE: (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Pastor Argue. I now call to order the eighteenth day of Ninety-Fifth legislative session. Roll call. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections this morning, Mr. President.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Messages, reports, and announcements?

CLERK: Just one item. A report from the Department...Nebraska Health and Human Services System annual report. That will be on file in the Clerk's Office. That's all that I have, Mr. President.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Moving on to General File, first item.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 132, introduced by Senator Bohlke. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 9, referred to the Education Committee. The bill was discussed briefly yesterday, Mr. President. At that time the committee amendments were offered by Senator Bohlke as the Chair of the Education Committee. Senator Witek had offered amendment 153, that's found on page 509. That is what's pending, Mr. President.
