SPEAKER WITHEM PRESIDING

SPEAKER WITHEM: Morning, ladies and gentlemen. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber as we begin today, the twenty-sixth day of the Ninety-Fifth Legislature, First Session. Very pleased to have, from St. Teresa Parish, here in Lincoln, Father Joseph Nemeč who will be delivering the invocation.

FATHER NEMEC: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you very much, Father. Members, would you please record your presence.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Quorum is present. Legislature is currently in session. Mr. Clerk, are there any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Are there any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Government, Military and Veterans Affairs, Chaired by Senator Robinson, reports LB 49, (LB) 162, (LB) 526 and LR 43CA to General File; LB 33, (LB) 70 to General File with committee amendments attached; and LB 145, (LB) 414, (LB) 670 and LR 11CA as indefinitely postponed. Those reports all signed by Senator Robinson. I have a series of hearing notices from the Appropriations Committee, signed by Senator Wehrbein as its Chair. That's all that I have, Mr. President. SPEAKER WITHEM: Very good, Mr. Clerk. We'll proceed to General File, LB 229.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 229, originally introduced by Senator Wickersham. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 13 of this year, at that time referred to the Judiciary Committee. The bill was advanced to General File.
