SENATOR KRISTENSEN: For legitimate criminal investigations and for the agencies listed in section 81-102, subsection (2).

SENATOR SCHIMEK: So, am I correct in my assumption that only people employed by these agencies might use those plates?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Yes.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: I thought I maybe heard you talk a little bit earlier about people in some kind of protection program. Could they....

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Well, that's the undercover operator's license. Now, there's a difference between an...there's a difference between the plates and there's a difference between the operator's license.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Okay. Would you talk about the operator's license...

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Okay.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: ...a little bit, then?

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: The operator's license...you would fill out an application, you'd come in, state the purpose, it's only issued to governmental agencies there, okay?

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Okay.
