SPEAKER WITHEM PRESIDING

SPEAKER WITHEM: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Very pleased to have with us today, from Our Saviour's Lutheran Church, here in Lincoln, Pastor Larry Kassebaum who will be delivering the morning invocation.

PASTOR KASSEBAUM: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you very much. Members, will you please record your presence. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Are there any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections this morning, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Are there any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, at this time, I have no messages, reports, or announcements.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Do we have any legislative resolutions?

CLERK: We do. Mr. President, we have LR 81, offered by Senator Hillman. It's found on page 785 of the Journal.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Okay, and again the agenda does not necessarily reflect this, but it would be my intentions to take LRs 81, 82 and 83 concurrently for purposes of debate and voting. Senator Hillman.

SENATOR HILLMAN: Yes, Mr. Chairman, members. The resolution this morning, LR 81, is kind of two-part, it's to honor two different entities here, one of them is Gering High School, and the other is Coach Peter, who is the wrestling coach at Gering High School. Little past history of the wrestling team in Gering High School, because we're very proud of it, is they did
