SENATOR COORDSEN PRESIDING

SENATOR COORDSEN: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber, for the thirty-seventh day. Chaplain for the day...thirty-eighth? Oh, okay...is Father Michael Christensen, St. Peter's Parish. It doesn't say where, here in Lincoln, Nebraska. Father.

FATHER MICHAEL CHRISTENSEN: (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Father. I now call to order the thirty-eighth day of the Ninety-Fifth Legislature, First Session. Roll call. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Any messages, reports, and announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Enrollment and Review reports they've examined and engrossed LB 266 and find the same correctly engrossed, (LB) 273, (LB) 623, and (LB) 720, all bills reported correctly engrossed. Mr. President, priority bill designations; Senator Cudaback has selected LB 70, Senator Kiel LB 648, Senator Engel (LB) 882. I have a gubernatorial appointment letter, will be referred to Reference for confirmation hearing purposes. Attorney General's Opinion to Senator Schrock. (Re: LB 100.) Finally, Mr. President, new A bill, (LB) 24A by Senator Maurstad. (Read by title for the first time.) That's all that I have, Mr. President. (See pages 941-49 of the Legislative Journal.)
