SPEAKER WITHEM PRESIDING

SPEAKER WITHEM: (Microphone not activated immediately.)  
...Chamber as we begin today, the forty-first day of the  
Ninety-Fifth Legislature, First Session. Would like to  
introduce our chaplain for the day, Pastor Darrell Sheeley, from  
the Highlands Missionary Baptist Church in Omaha, Senator Will's  
district.

PASTOR SHEELEY: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you very much, Pastor. Members, please  
record your presence. Members in your office, we do have a full  
agenda this morning and we do need a quorum on the floor, if you  
would please come to the floor and check in, so we can get  
started. Mr. Clerk, will you please record.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Quorum is present. The Legislature is in  
session. Mr. Clerk, are there any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: No corrections, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Are there any messages, reports, or  
announcements?

CLERK: Enrollment and Review reports LB 249 and 622 to Select  
File with E & R amendments attached. Senator Dierks has  
selected LB 552 as his personal priority bill. Senator Schrock  
has selected LB 877. Gubernatorial appointment will be referred  
to Reference; Lobby Report for this past week; a series of  
reports from the various natural resources districts with  
respect to payment of attorney fees. Those will be on file in  
the Clerk's Office and are filed pursuant to statute. Senator  
Schimek, amendment to be printed to LB 321; Senator Schellpeper  
to LB 518. That's all that I have, Mr. President. (See
