SENATOR CROSBY PRESIDING

SENATOR CROSBY: Good afternoon and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. This is the forty-sixth day, Monday, March 24, 1997 of the Ninety-Fifth Legislature, First Session. Our chaplain today is our own Harland Johnson.

REVEREND JOHNSON: (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Harland. Roll call. Will senators please record your presence. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. Any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: Any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: Madam President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports they have examined engrossed LB 30 and find the same correctly engrossed; (LB) 51, (LB) 54, (LB) 166, (LB) 246, (LB) 362, (LB) 362A, (LB) 531, (LB) 641, (LB) 641A, and (LB) 734, those all reported correctly engrossed. That's all that I have at this time, Madam President. (See pages 1186-87 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Before we start the agenda, Senator DiAnna Schimek announces that Dr. Hank Newburn, of Lincoln, Nebraska, is our family doctor of the day. He's under the north balcony. And Senator Don Pederson has, as his guest today, his wife, Virginia Pederson, and Laura, Tim, and Matt Pederson, who are his grandchildren. They're all from North Platte. Would you and the doctor, please all stand and be welcomed by your Legislature. We'll proceed to General File. Mr. Clerk, LB 465.

CLERK: Madam President, 465, introduced by Senator Schellpeper and others. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 16 of this year, at that time was referred to the Judiciary Committee. The bill was advanced to General File,
