SPEAKER WITHEM PRESIDING

SPEAKER WITHEM: (Recorder not activated immediately) ...this being the forty-seventh day of the Ninety-Fifth Legislature, First Session, would like to introduce our chaplain for the day, he is Pastor Dale Ribble, from the Oak Lake Evangelical Free Church, here in Lincoln. Pastor.
