SENATOR COORDSEN PRESIDING

SENATOR COORDSEN: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Chamber for the fifty-third day of the Ninety-Fifth Legislature. Our Chaplain for the Day is Pastor Joel Nau, intern pastor, Lutheran Student Center on the University of Nebraska campus right here in Lincoln. Good morning.
