SPEAKER WITHEM: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Very pleased this morning, as we begin our sixty-fourth day of the Ninety-Fifth Legislature, First Session, to have with us, from Senator Vrtiska's district, the Faith Lutheran Church in Talmage, we have Pastor William Dressen.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: A quorum is present. Are there any corrections to the Journal?

SPEAKER WITHEM: Any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: I have no messages, reports, or announcements this morning, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: The Chair would recognize Senator Bohlke prior to beginning debate. Or maybe, Mr. Clerk, call up the bill first, and then Senator Bohlke has indicated to me ahead of time that she has a request for scheduling purposes.

CLERK: Mr. President, 806 on General File. Committee amendments have been divided. The Legislature has been discussing the first component thereof.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Senator Bohlke, you had a scheduling request?

SENATOR BOHLKE: Yes, Mr. Speaker. As we adjourned last week we were on Senator Bromm's amendment to Section 1. We have three more sections to the bill.
