SENATOR COORDSEN PRESIDING

SENATOR COORDSEN: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen. Welcome to the George W. Norris Chamber. Our chaplain for the day is Rabbi Stanley Rosenbaum from Tifereth Israel Synagogue here in Lincoln, Nebraska. Rabbi Rosenbaum.

RABBI STANLEY ROSENBAUM: (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you for your message this morning, Rabbi. I now call to order the eighty-third day of the Ninety-Fifth Legislature, First Session. Roll call.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Do we have any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Any messages, reports, and announcements.

CLERK: Mr. President, just one item, Reference Report referring study resolutions as approved by the Executive Board yesterday. That's the only item I have, Mr. President.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Moving to consent calendar, General File A bills, Mr. Clerk, LB 626A. Final Reading, please take your seats. We will begin Final Reading with LB 94. Mr. Clerk. As soon as the members...return to your seats, please. We are on Final Reading. Mr. Clerk, proceed with Final Reading, LB 94.

CLERK: (Read LB 94 on Final Reading.)

SENATOR COORDSEN: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 2385 of the Legislative Journal.) 31 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 17 excused and not voting, Mr. President.
