SPEAKER WITHEM: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen, welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber as we begin today, the eighty-fourth day of the Ninety-Fifth Legislature, First Session. Very pleased to have Pastor Greg Berger from Redeemer Lutheran Church from Hooper, Nebraska, in Senator Janssen's district.

PASTOR BERGER: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you very much. Members, please record your presence.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Quorum is present. Mr. Clerk, are there any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Are there any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Witek, an amendment to (LB) 798 to be printed, and I have a motion from the Speaker to be printed. (See page 2441 of the Legislative Journal.) That's all that I had, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: In that case, members, please take your seats. Sergeant of Arms, please secure the Chamber for Final Reading. Mr. Clerk, LB 49.

CLERK: (Read LB 49 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 49 pass? All in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 2442 of the Legislative Journal.) 36 ayes, 0 nays, 13 excused and not voting, Mr. President.
