SPEAKER WITHEM PRESIDING

SPEAKER WITHEM: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen. I'd like to welcome you all to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber as we begin today, the eighty-fifth day of the Ninety-Fifth Legislature, First Session. Very pleased to have with us from Tecumseh...the First (sic) Baptist Church in Tecumseh, Pastor Dan Gonnerman.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Thank you very much, Pastor. Members, would you please report to the Chamber and record your presence.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Quorum is present. Mr. Clerk, are there any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Are there any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: I have no messages, reports, or announcements.

SPEAKER WITHEM: Members, please take your seats. Sergeant of Arms, please prepare the Chamber for Final Reading. Mr. Clerk. Members, if you could, take your seats, please. We are on Final Reading. Mr. Clerk, please read LB 180.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 180 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER WITHEM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 180 pass? All of those in favor vote aye. Opposed vote nay. Have all of you voted who care to vote? Have all of you voted who care to vote? Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 2494-95 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 26 ayes, 4 nays, 2 present not voting, 17 excused and not voting.
