SENATOR COORDSEN PRESIDING

SENATOR COORDSEN: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen. Welcome to the George W. Norris Chamber. Our chaplain for today is our own chaplain coordinator, Harland Johnson.

HARLAND JOHNSON: (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Mr. Johnson. I now call to order the eighty-sixth day of the Ninety-Fifth Legislature, First Session. Roll call.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Any messages, reports and announcements?
