PRESIDENT ROBAK PRESIDING

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Good morning, and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain for the day is Pastor Charles Borcharding from Redeemer Lutheran Church in Lincoln. Pastor Borcharding.
