SPEAKER KRISTENSEN PRESIDING

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Good morning. Our chaplain for the day is Major Robert Boone, from the Salvation Army, here in Lincoln. Major.

MAJOR BOONE: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you. Check in.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: We next move to the adoption of temporary rules. Senator Bromm.

SENATOR BROMM: Mr. Speaker, I move that the rules, as now in our possession, be adopted for today only, Tuesday, January 13, 1998.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you. All those in favor of the adoption of the temporary rules say aye. Those opposed say nay. On the ruling of the Chair, they're approved. Mr. Clerk, corrections or additions to the Journal.
